Declaration on the REACH Regulation

To whom it may concern

According to Article 59 of the REACH Regulation (EC) 1907/2006, substances are included in the Candidate List for Authorization (as of 25.06.2025) after they have been identified as Substance of Very High Concern (SVHC).

Article 31 (1) of the REACH Regulation requires the supplier of a substance or mixture to provide the recipient of the substance or mixture with a safety data sheet if a substance as such or as part of a mixture is on the Candidate List for Authorization.

Article 33 of the REACH Regulation obliges the supplier of an article containing at least 0.1%-(m/m) of a substance of very high concern on the candidate list to provide sufficient information on the safe use of the article, or at least to disclose the name of the substance concerned to the recipient.

The pipes and profiles you purchase from us are articles in accordance with REACH Regulation Article 3 No. 3 and are not subject to registration, as the substances used are not changed during processing. When our products are used as intended, there is no intended release of the ingredients. To the best of our current knowledge, the products we supply to you do not contain any substances of very high concern from the currently published candidate list for authorization above 0.1%-(m/m). Therefore, the information obligation according to Article 33 of the REACH Regulation does not currently apply to us.

Of course, we check the status of the authorization candidate list within our company at regular intervals and will therefore inform you immediately should any relevant changes occur in this regard.
